MANAGING CHILDREN AWAY FROM THE CLUB POLICY

Barwell Cricket Club will adopt the following guidelines, which are based on those provided by the ECB.

The guiding principles are:

- Follow ECB supervision guidance for cricket activities involving children.
- Have an agreed transport policy in place at the club.
- Ensure the team has agreed to act within the appropriate ECB and/or Club Code of Conducts.
- A team manager will establish and communicate the following information to parent(s);
 - When the match, competition or trip will take place including the date, time of departure and estimated time of return.
 - Where to, including the destination and venue.
 - Where the meeting points will be, at home and at the away venue.
 - Staffing arrangements, including the name and contact details of the Team Manager responsible for the trip.
 - Kit and equipment requirements.
 - Details of cost implications.
- Managers to be in possession of a written copy of relevant emergency contact details and any medical information for all children taking part.
- All members of staff need to have clear knowledge of their role and responsibility for the team.
