About Us

Barwell Cricket Club is a non-profit organisation affiliated to the England and Wales Cricket Board through the Leicestershire and Rutland Cricket League and is run by a committee elected at the club's Annual General Meeting (AGM).

The club was founded in 1807 when the friendly rivalry between two local vicars lead to the first fixture between Barwell Cricket Club and Coventry and North Warwickshire Cricket Club being played. It is now reputed to be the Oldest Continuous Club Cricket Match in England.

The purpose of the club is to foster and promote participation in the amateur sport of cricket within the community, providing opportunities for recreation, coaching, and competition.

The club's home is at the Kirkby Road Sports Ground, Kirkby Road, Barwell, LE9 8FQ where the club has a longstanding informal agreement to use the ground given by the trustees of the complex. We share the use of the complex with Barwell Football Club and indoors and outdoors bowls clubs.

The club currently runs **three** senior Saturday teams in the Leicestershire and Rutland Cricket League (L&RCL) as well as **two** senior teams in the Nuneaton Thursday League. We also have a thriving Junior section with teams from ages 6 - 8 to Under 17s, including Women's & Girl's cricket.
